What is the most important thing you can do in your life?

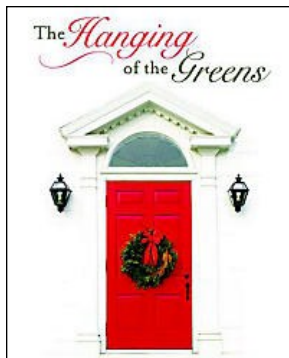

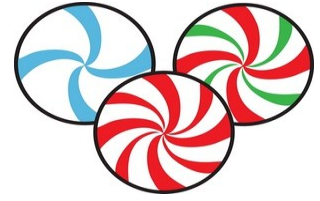
